We are also working closely with our builder partners to keep working as long as we are all able to safely do so. EnergyLogic, like all other organizations, is fully engaged in monitoring, planning, and trying to make the best decisions regarding the impacts of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

On Friday, March 13, 2020, we received information that the City of Thornton Building Department may be suspending all activities including field inspections. We assume that other jurisdictions will follow suit, which will drastically impact building schedules.

As of this moment, EnergyLogic's plan is to *continue* to provide field inspections as scheduled by our clients. We are mobilizing our scheduling department to allow for a work from home environment which may affect our response time.

Due to the financial importance of closing houses and the rapidly changing information, EnergyLogic will prioritize final inspections over rough inspections so that our clients can get to closing with less delay.
